It's Camp Time Again

This is the 2016 Registration Form for this year's FCBC Northland Summer Camp. Please read the entire form and then fill it out completely, including the health form, and be sure to sign it and then mail it in by May 15. We look forward to seeing you there!

Location – Directions – Contacts

Northland Summer Camp is located at the Norway Point Group Center in the heart of beautiful St. Croix State Park. Take I-35 (north from the Twin Cities) to the Hinckley exit. Go east on Highway 48, 15 miles, to the entrance of St. Croix State Park. Turn right, and go five miles to the Ranger Station. (Note: Camp ground parking fees are \$4 per night, or \$25 per week. You must pay the daily fee (\$4) even if just dropping off your child for camp. So carpool if you have a chance.) The Park Rangers will gladly give you directions to Norway Point. Age of Campers

Our camp is primarily designed for kids 9 to 18 years of age (those who have completed the 3rd - 12th grades). All campers, regardless of age, are expected to obey the rules of Northland Camp.

Cost

The cost for Northland Camp 2016 is **\$ 200** for the first camper in each family, **\$ 180** for the second family member, then **\$ 160** for all other children in the same family. Camp fees include a camp T-shirt, an autograph book, lodging, three great meals per day, and all activities. We believe this is a true bargain for a week of summer camp to each child. Our entire staff is all-volunteer, thus keeping our expenses down to a minimum. Camp fees do not include spending money for crafts, snacks, or transportation to and from camp. If you would like to pre-pay you are welcome to send monthly installments to our registrar, Sandy Guzzo, at the address on the bottom of this form. Also, there will be a **late fee of \$15** for any who do not register before **May 15**. All it takes is a \$20 deposit to register. You can pay the rest later. So please, send it in ASAP.

Conduct and Dress

It is the purpose of Northland Camp to provide a wholesome camping experience in a spiritual atmosphere consistent with the principles found within the Word of God. Each camper is expected to follow camp rules and obey the instructions of the staff. **Campers and staff are required to wear modest clothing. Specifically, all skirts, pants, or shorts must touch the knee at all times, whether standing or sitting. All shirts should be loose fitting, and must cover the midriff at all times. Tank tops are not permitted, but shirts without sleeves will be permitted as long as the armholes are small. Clothing with pictures or messages will be allowed as long as they are not offensive** (“offensive” will be determined by the Camp Director and his staff). Boys and girls are encouraged to dress casually and comfortably (T-shirts, jeans, sweat pants, or capris). Daily camp attire will be suitable for all camp functions, eliminating the need for frequent changes. Clothing and modesty rules will be strictly enforced.

Possession of tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs, or weapons (including pocket knives) of any kind is not permitted at camp. Profanity, stealing, or abuse of the camp facilities will not be tolerated. **No camper** will be allowed to drive motorized vehicles while on site during the week. Vehicles must be parked and keys turned over to the Director. Respect must be shown between boys and girls at all times.

Activities

Our schedule will include daily Bible study classes, singings, devotions, crafts, athletic events (such as softball and volleyball), campfires, talent show, and a variety of group activities.

Visitors

Beginning at 1:30 p.m. on Friday, June 17th, family and friends are invited to visit the campground. Guests are welcomed to join us for dinner, and attend our ever-popular talent show in the evening. Guests are also invited to spend the night with us at Norway Point. You will be charged **\$2.00** for dinner and **\$5.00** for your evening accommodations (this is what the Park charges us). All guests must register with the Director.

Registration Forms

All forms (Registration, Health, and Immunization) must be filled out and mailed to our Registrar, **Sandy Guzzo**, by **May 15**. Registrations post marked after May 15 will be charged a **\$15** late registration fee. A deposit of **\$20.00** must be sent with your forms to reserve a space at camp. Please note, this \$20 will be applied to your camp fee (Illustration: \$190 - \$20 fee = \$170 final payment). All remaining fees must be paid in full by **June 6th**. Deposits will only be refunded if you cancel your camp reservation by June 6th. Notification of your ‘balance due’ will be received in a future mailing (sometime in May).

If making multiple smaller payments would be helpful for your budgeting purposes, our Registrar, Sandy Guzzo, will be happy to work with you. Call her at 763-753-0001.

Please note: Early registration and on time full payment for camp helps us in a number of ways. Cabin assignment requests, proper T-shirt sizes (or even receiving one since we have to order them several weeks before camp) cannot be guaranteed for those who register late. Thank you for helping us out by **registering early!** And this Year you qualify for a FREE Camp shirt before May 15th.
